

Woodstock Local Lottery

Rules of the Lottery Club are as follows:

- 1. The Lottery will be run under the Gambling Act 2005 Small Society Lottery. The promoter will be Julian Cooper
- 2. The Club reserves the right to amend the rules of the YC Lottery from time to time, as may be necessary. A copy of current rules will be available on our Website
- 3. All profits made from this lottery will be used to fund the New Building for the Youth Club
- 4. The Lottery will be limited to maximum of 500 members.
- 5. The subscription will be £1 per weekly ticket, payable, quarterly £13, half yearly £26 or yearly £52 by standing order on the 1st of the month, cheque giving 8 days clearance time or cash. On receipt of payment a Draw Number or multiples there of. This/These allocated number/s will be the payees whilst in credit. In the event of a lapse in payment your allocated number will be made void to you and re-allocated by demand of purchase request.
- 6. A draw will take place every week for a 1st 2nd & 3rd cash prize. Winners will be notified by the committee, and the winning numbers will be available for inspection at the Youth Club and on our website
- 7. 50% of the total annual subscription will be paid out in the form of cash prizes: for this purpose the lottery will run for 52 weeks starting on 14th January 2014
- 8. The weekly draw will be conducted by 3 people, one of which will be the Chair or vice chair of the club.
- 9. No Lottery participant will be included in the draw if the appropriate subscription has not been received by Payment condition as at rule 5 The Promoter reserves the right to reallocate any numbers where payment has no been received on time.
- 10. Prizes will be paid by cheque only, addressed to the person holding the winning number.
- 11. In the event of there being less than 500 participants, prizes shall be awarded on a pro rata basis of the actual number of tickets sold at the time of the draw 50% of funds received in that week will be paid out in cash prizes.
 - $(1^{st} = 80\% \ 2^{nd} = 12\% \ 3^{rd} = 8\%)$ Participants can cancel their entry in the lottery at any time by giving one months written notice to the Promoter (if paying by standing order they should also advise their bank) Any decision by the club to wind up the lottery draw will also be by one months written notice. Under no circumstances will any payment be refunded.
